

Pom-Pom Sorting & Counting Mats

Three mats: sort by colour, count 1-6, and make a pom-pom pattern.

What you need: this printable, a bag of craft pom-poms and a pair of tongs or tweezers.

Page 2 - Colour sorting mat: drop each pom-pom onto the circle of its colour.

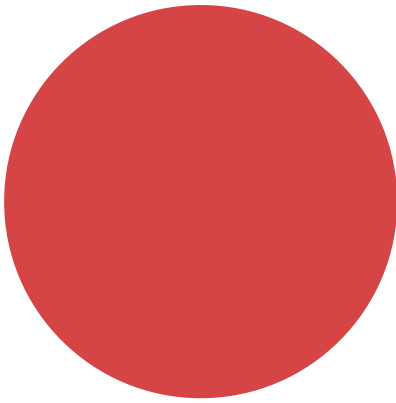
Page 3 - Counting mat: put the matching number of pom-poms in each row.

Page 4 - Pattern strips: copy the pattern, then invent one and ask someone to copy yours.

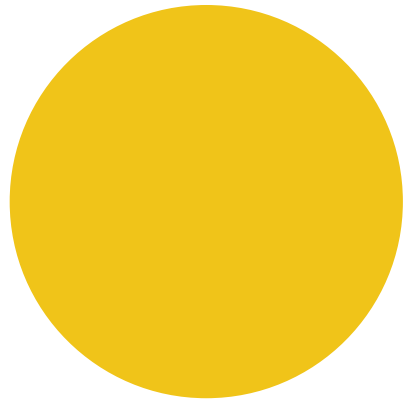
Laminate the pages (or slide them into a plastic sleeve) and they last for years.

Tongs turn this into serious fine-motor work; fingers are perfectly fine for toddlers.

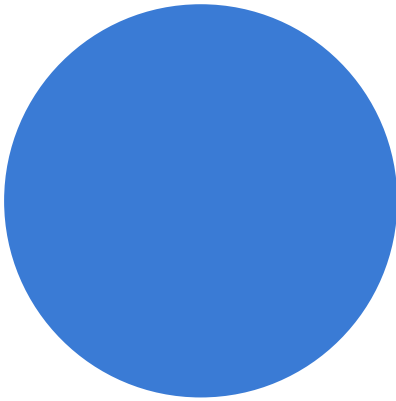

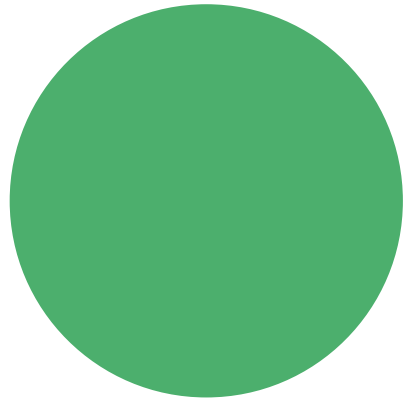

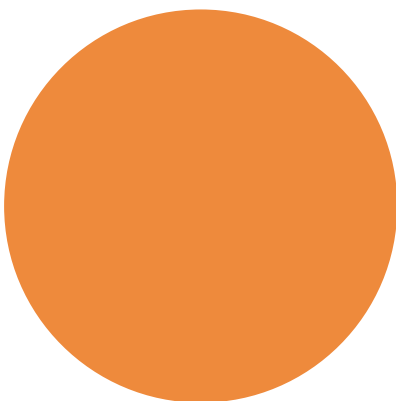

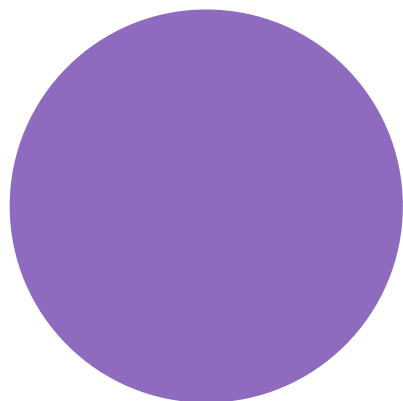
