

Texture Rubbing Pages

Slide something flat under the page, rub with a crayon, watch it appear.

What you need: this printable, wax crayons with the paper peeled off, and a collection of flat textured things: leaves, coins, keys, lace, bark, cardboard, a doily.

Page 2 - Six labelled frames to fill: leaf, coin, bark, lace, cardboard, your own find.

Page 3 - Guess-the-texture cards: make a rubbing, cut the card out, and let someone match the rubbing to the real object.

Page 4 - A big blank frame for a whole-page collage of overlapping rubbings.

Rub with the long side of the crayon, not the tip, and hold the paper still with your other hand. Thin paper gives the sharpest print.

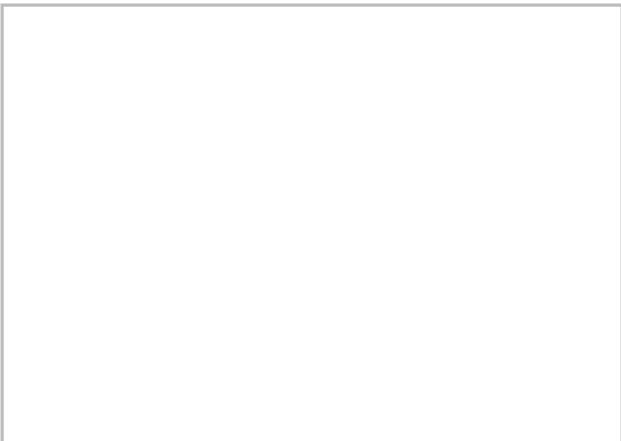
A leaf



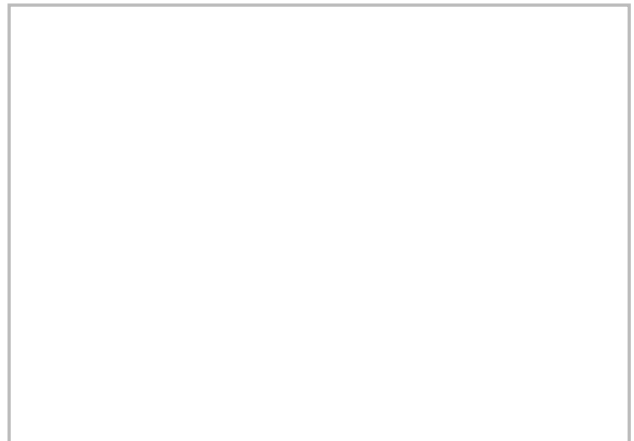
A coin



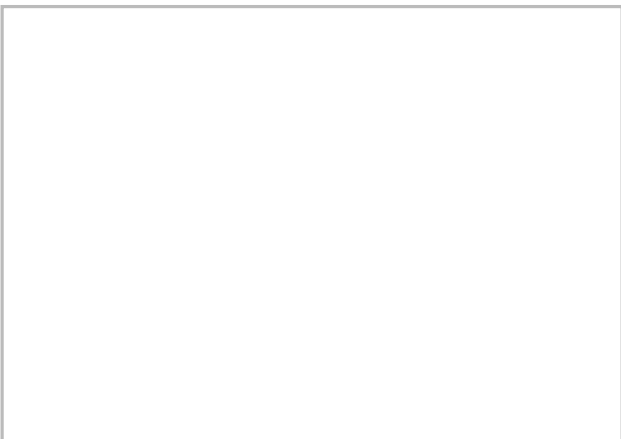
Tree bark



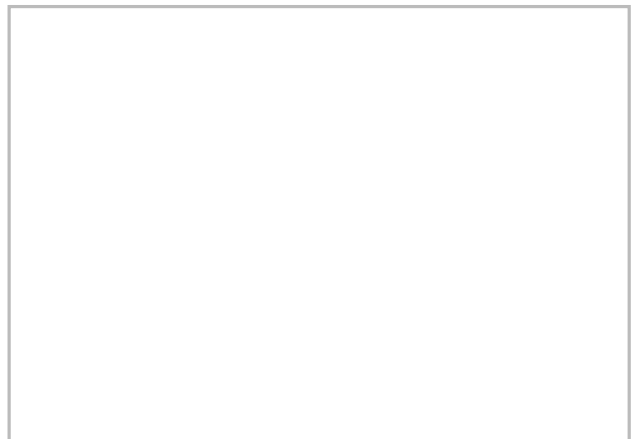
Lace or fabric
